

## NON-ACADEMIC SURVEYS AND QUESTIONNAIRES

This policy regulates non-academic surveys and questionnaires.

A non-academic survey or questionnaire is defined as surveys, questionnaires, or other documents designed to elicit information about a student's social behavior, family life, religion, politics, sexual orientation, sexual activity, drug use, or any other information not related to a student's academics or as otherwise may be defined by applicable state law or Department of Education regulation.

The School District shall notify parents/guardians of the survey/questionnaire and its purpose. No student shall be required to volunteer for or submit to a non-academic survey or questionnaire without written consent (opt in) of a parent or legal guardian unless the student is an adult or an emancipated minor. One exception is the Youth Risk Behavior Survey where parents/guardians can opt-out with written notification.

The District will make the non-academic survey or questionnaire available on the school or school district's website 10 days prior to distribution.
