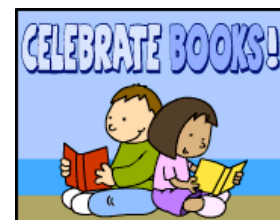
In addition, many students become very close to their teacher and will greatly miss
