The first day of school is Tuesday, September 1.

We'll have school two days that week, the 1st and 2nd, and staff will be engaged in workshops on Thursday, as we collaborate together to learn more about all of our children. There's no school on Friday.

School starts at 8:00 AM and students are dismissed at 2:35 PM. If you bring your child to school, please have them wait on the playground for the bell. Teachers will come out to the playground to meet their students.

NEW AND RETURNING PARENTS

PTA will host a "Boo Hoo Breakfast/Coffee with Carozza" this year for the first day of school. Please join us outside by the main entrance for some treats and conversation with fellow parents after the kids reach their classrooms. We will also hold

the event at 11:20 for the afternoon kindergarten parents. Because we split the kindergarten class up the first two days of school, we will hold the breakfast on the second day of school as well at 8 AM and 11:20 for day two kindergarten parents. We look forward to seeing you!

FACILITY CHANGES

The new walkway extending from Main Street into our school paid for through Safe Routes to Schools grant funding will hopefully be constructed before the school year begins. Look for a grand opening of the walkway this fall. In addition, our expert custodians have been working all summer to get the building ready for opening. We also welcome our new Facilities Director Dick Fortier to the district.



BUSES

Bus routes will be posted soon on our district web site, hopkintonschools.org.

To make the first day of school go smoothly, fill out the enclosed school bus form and attach it securely to your child’s lunchbox, backpack, or jacket. Please use the route number for the bus number. They are the same. This “bus” is a great aid in helping students remember their bus number and find the right bus home.

When students arrive at school, they should go directly to the playground. Students should look for a tall bus sign with the appropriate color:

- Kindergarten: Pink
- First grade: Yellow
- Second grade: Blue
- Third grade: Green

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

In order to make arrival in the morning safer for those who are driving in, please note our procedure:

- As you enter into the school lot head counter-clockwise and go into the lane which will be clearly marked with sawhorses every morning. This will prevent cars from driving around other cars dropping off children.
- Go all the way to the front of that lane that will be marked clearly, essentially at the end of the fire lane. This way there will be more room for the cars behind you.
- Carefully dismiss your child from the sidewalk side of your vehicle and they can then walk down to the playground.
- If you would rather walk your child down yourself, you will need to park and carefully walk through the parking lot to the sidewalk.
- The last three spaces in the parking lot's first row are reserved for preschool parking until 8:20 every morning.

For safety measures, please do not cut across the parking lot.

Only school buses are allowed to drive around the circular roadway by the flagpole from 7:00-8:15 AM and 2:30-3:30 PM.

When dropping your child off, please do so promptly so that other cars behind you do not have to wait long. Please do not drop your child off past 8 AM if possible. It is really is crucial that students begin the day on time. Thank you.

If you are picking up your child at the close of the school day, please park your car in the parking lot and sign your child out in the preschool room (formally the music room) where you may wait for him or her. Please do not go to the classroom to meet your child. In general, if you are changing your child's end of the day destination, please send a note in to your child's teacher. If you know at least a day ahead, you may also email this information to Administrative Assistant, Betsy Wilder, at bwilder@hopkintonschools.org. With the nature of email, there are no guarantees that we will receive an email the same day you send it out. In general, please do not pick your child up later than 2:35. If for some reason you are running late, your child will be waiting in the office where you may sign him or her out.



Milk and Hot Lunch Money

Enclosed with this letter you will find a money envelope for the first week of school (two days). Hot lunch will be served every day. The menu for Tuesday is: Pizza, Veggie Stix, Popcorn, pudding or fruit. On Wednesday the lunch will be: Hotdog on a roll, Baked Beans French Fries and fruit or cookie.

These envelopes will be sent home every Friday. Please return them to school the following Tuesday (after Labor Day) for that week. Be sure to put your child's name on the envelope, check off your child's choice for the day and indicate the amount of money enclosed. Checks should be made out to *Hopkinton Hot Lunch Program*.

Breakfast is served every morning at school, including the first day of school, and all children may participate.

Prices are as follows:
Lunch: \$2.25
Milk, Juice: 40 cents
Breakfast: \$1.00

NOTE: Whole Milk will not be served this year.



Visitors

All visitors to the Harold Martin School are required to use the front door by the main office and sign in on the sheet for visitors. This includes all times of the day, even first thing in the morning. All other doors are kept locked for security purposes.

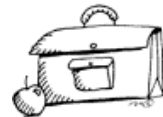
