Dear Parents,

Field trips and outdoor activities are in full swing here at Harold Martin School and that means sun and bugs. This would also apply to morning recess. Bugspray and sunscreen must come from home with a note of permission for application. An example of your note could read "Please apply sunscreen and/or bugspray to ...(your child's name)... for lunch recess or on a field trip." Please label any containers with your child's name. We cannot apply these items without your permission and we do not have a supply here at school. It would be best to apply the sunscreen and/or bug spray to your child before coming to school if needed for early morning recess. This is a very busy time of day and since all the students are on the playground it would be very difficult to start applying sunscreen and bug spray.
